The Church was organized about one mile South of its present location.

A tabernacle was built, but we have no date for this event. Mr. Charlie Owens and J.V. Allen were the Trustees.



In later years, “church” was held in Stiff Chapel Schoolhouse beside the Tabernacle.

According to records, Brother Hold was the earliest pastor. In 1915, Brother J.L. Truett was pastor who is a brother of George W. Truett. Deacons in 1915 were listed as B.F. Davidson and E.M. Watson.



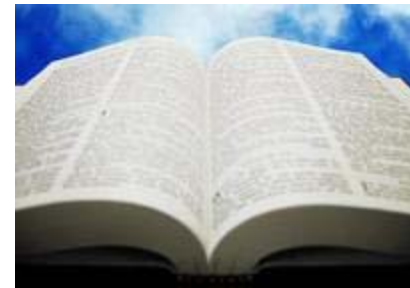
